- 1. What do you do when something seems too good to be true?
- 2. Israel was God's illustration of what grace could do for the entire world. How might the church be an illustration of God's grace for the world?
- 3. Which of God's promises sound too good to be true?
- 4. The Queen of Sheba was open to being wrong, open to learning more, and wanted to know what's true. What makes having this kind of healthy skepticism difficult?
- 5. The church is not a place where you come to pretend you believe the right answers, but a place where you come to ask all your best questions. How have you experienced this to be true?
- 6. We come to see the goodness of God through reading the Bible and prayer. How have you experienced this to be true?
- 7. Share examples of how you have walked away believing, worshiping, and blessed after seeing the greatness of God for yourself.
